The Helicopter CM COI is a challenging and demanding course that trains its students to become leaders in this unique industry. The CM course teaches the student how to control, manage, and supervise groups of helicopter jumpers into a safe situation utilizing the CM's helicopter, safety personnel, waterborne safety platforms, as well as implementing other imperative assets and pertinent persons.

Students must learn how to manage, organize, lead and have a general knowledge of all the hard safety assets and platforms involved with each jump to include:

- Coast Guard COI (Certificate of Inspection) commercial boats.
- Dive Propulsion Vehicles (DPV's).
- FAA Certified helicopters for Helicopter Casting.
- Department of Land and Natural Resources (DLNR) certified maritime Mobile Rescue Vehicles (MRV's)/Jet skis.
- Any other safety platforms required for casting within a specific Area of Operation (AO) as per local, state, and federal laws and regulations.

The student must also master the lead role and responsibility of all safety personnel involved in

a casting operation to include:

- FAA approved pilots for helicopter casting operations.
- Coast Guard certified commercial boat captains.
- Life guard certified safety swimmers.
- DLNR certified MRV/Jet ski operators.

- Any other safety personnel required for casting operations within a specific Area of Operation (AO) as per local, state, and federal laws and regulations.

This course is both academic and performance-based. It requires each CM student to prepare and give many presentations, safety briefings, and display an intimate knowledge of every aspect involved in a casting operation. This COI involves intense waterborne practical training exercises, including both subsurface and surface waterman rescue swimmer skills. Students will culminate their training by applying their knowledge and skills during realistic scenarios and enacting emergency action drills.

This course provides students with extensive development in project management and includes a heavy emphasis on asset/personnel management. The CM must have a general knowledge of each asset, key safety personnel and be able to enact all levels of safety protocols. This course also provides exposure to a variety of aquatic environments in order to prepare them for a profession in the industry. This course is academically, mentally, and physically demanding, requiring a 100% full commitment from the CM student to be successful. Upon graduation, the CM student will be awarded a FAA recognized, Trident Adventures Helicopter Cast Master commercial certification and will be officially qualified to perform professional-level CM duties within FAA recognized DZ airspaces.

Prerequisites:

- Minimum 18-years old.
- Submit the provided medical clearance documents, valid within last 12-months.
- Must pass the minimum standards for the Physical Fitness Test (Appendix A-21).
- The classroom required hours are 73 hours.
