The DM Course is a challenging yet rewarding program that trains divers to learn how to look beyond themselves to consider the safety and well-being of other divers. This course is performance-based and consists of briefing presentations and intense open water practical training exercises. The culmination of the student's education is tested through the application of their knowledge and skills during realistic training scenarios and academic examinations. The DM course teaches the student how to lead, control, manage, and supervise groups of divers in a professional setting. This course provides students with extensive development of diving skills and includes a heavy emphasis in various aspects of the diving community as a profession. Upon completion, DMs will be qualified to begin the next step in professional scuba diving in the Assistant Instructor COI. The vocational objective of this course is for the student to obtain the PADI Divemaster rating and certification, which is recognized as the entry-level professional diving certification.

Prerequisites:

- Minimum 18 years old.
- Provide medical clearance documents, valid within last 12 months.
- 40 logged dives prior to starting the Diversater portion (60 prior to completion).
- This course requires 129 classroom hours

Please note that all students need additional hours to study, practice, and log additional required dives. These should be done in the student's free time.
