Details:

This course prepares the student to take the Instructor Exam (IE) and function as a Scuba Instructor and Emergency First Response Instructor. This introduces the student to the entire PADI system of dive education. It further develops the abilities as a professional dive educator. This course develops the student's teaching ability, dive knowledge, skill level and understanding of the entire system of dive education. After completion of this course, the student will have mastered all the skills required as a dive educator and will be properly prepared to take the (IE) examination.

Prerequisites:

- Minimum 18-years old.
- Submit the provided medical clearance documents, valid within last 12-months.
- Current Active-Status Divemaster Certification & EFR Certification.
- Proof of 60+ logged dives to begin course.
- Proof of 100+ logged dives to attend the Instructor Exam.
- Must be a certified diver for a minimum of (6) months before enrolling.
- Each student must provide their own professional level dive gear able to meet all the minimum standards before starting the OWSI COI.
- The classroom hours for this course is 89 hours.

Please note that all students need additional hours to study, practice, and log additional required dives. These should be done in the student's free time.
